## **EGD/ERCP Procedure Prep Instructions**

### **Medications**

The procedure you are scheduled to have will require you to stop certain medications for a set period prior to your procedure. Please see page 2 for further instructions on Blood Thinning Medications.

### **Diabetic Patients**

If you were not previously instructed on how to proceed with your medication, kindly contact our office at 813-653-3359 Option 7.

### **Prep instructions the day before the procedure**

- Nothing by mouth (NPO) after midnight the night before the procedure

### **On the day of the procedure**

- Take all blood pressure, heart, or seizure medication with a sip of water.
- Do not take any diabetic medications unless otherwise instructed to do so by your physician.
- **Please arrange for transportation**, you will be sedated and **cannot drive** or go home alone. Please avoid taking a cab/pick up services unless accompanied by an adult.

### **Cancellation or Rescheduling**

If you need to cancel or change your scheduled procedure, please contact our Procedure Scheduling Department at 813-653-3359 Option 3 at least 72 hours in advance.

- Aspirin
- Ibuprofen
- Advil
- Aleve
- Motrin
- Naproxen
- Meloxicam
- Tolmetin
- Indomethacin
- Sulindac
- Piroxicam
- Diclofenac
- Etodolac
- Advil Migraine
- Tylenol Migraine
- Excedrin Migraine
- Generic Migraine
- Any medication that has aspirin or aspirin type products in it

You can take Tylenol (Acetaminophen)

**Please follow these instructions *unless* directed differently by your provider.**

- Coumadin: Hold for 5 Full Days Prior To Procedure
- Pradaxa: Hold for 2 Full Days Prior To Procedure
- Xarelto: Hold for 1 Full Day Prior To Procedure
- Eliquis: Hold for 1 Full Day prior to Procedure

**The following medications DO NOT need to be held unless directed to do so by provider.**

- Effient
- Plavix
- Brilinta
